They were considered as “Commanders of the Faithful”. Some of them were appointed or elected by community consensus</p> <p>Below are the list of the five prominent caliphs in Islam:</p> <p>1st caliph Abubakar 2nd caliph Umar bin Al-khattab 3rd caliph Uthman bin Affan 4th caliph Ali ibn AbI Talib 5th caliph Abdur-Rahman bin Awf</p> <p>CALIPH ABUBAKAR CONTRIBUTION TO ISLAM</p> <p>1. He played critical roles in the spreading of the Islamic faith. He persuaded many people to join the faith.</p> <p>2. He also freed slaves by purchasing them from their masters. He spent 40,000 dinar to set free eight slaves.</p> <p>3. Teacher assist the pupils to come out with the importance of the ten commandment. <p>CLOSURE</p> <p>Teacher summaries the lesson and assign exercise to the pupils to answer.</p>	<p>Chalk board illustration</p> <p>Bible</p>	<p>MORAL LESSONS FROM THE TEN COMMANDMENTS</p> <p>The ten commandments are recognized as a moral foundation in Christianity (Refer to Exodus 20:1 – 20)</p> <p>THE TEN COMMANDMENTS</p> <p>THE SIXTH COMMANDMENT : - “<i>You shall not commit murder</i>”</p> <p>The moral teaching is that:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. no individual should attempt to take his or her life or that of other person 2. by aborting an unplanned pregnancy one has violated this commandment 3. one should not fight or throw objects at other since this can lead to accidental deaths <p>THE SEVENTH COMMANDMENT : - “<i>You shall not commit adultery</i>”</p> <p>The moral teaching is that:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Husbands and wives should be committed to their marriage vows. 2.
